Please Help Us Retain Our Ratings

(Just a few reminders)

Dogs: Please leash dogs at all time, and always carry a "doggie bag" with you when walking your dog. All shot records required.

Rubbish: Please no large bulky items in or near the dumpsters. See management about proper disposal of such items. Please break down all cardboard boxes and leave at the recycling center.

Trailers: Please remove all snowmobile, utility, boat, or other trailers from your site.

Tarps: Please use only brown tarps to cover your wood pile.

Septic System Connections: Once septic system connection reaches your site, ALL trailers connected to our sewer lines MUST be connected by air-tight solid PVC.

Site Work If you need to have work done on your site such as moving the trailer, , trailer set-up, etc., the labor charge will be \$65/hr with a \$65.00 minimum. Jobs require use of the tractor will be billed at \$80.00/hr with a minimum of \$40.00.
